A program focused on providing additional education and training to primary care nurse practitioner and PMHNP students on how to incorporate a whole health approach to their clinical practice.

- Attempt to be placed in a rural and/or medically underserved area for clinical placements, although not guaranteed
- Attend weekly Behavioral Health Integration seminars starting in the Spring semester
- Attend immersions, including Mental Health First Aid Training
- Participate in educational opportunities: case studies, podcasts, self-paced courses
- Attend one conference related to BHI/SUD
- Attend one ABCs of MOUD ECHO session/month starting in the Spring Semester
- Focus MSN paper or DNP project on BHI/SUD
- Complete all requested evaluations: this feedback is crucial to our grant sustainability and is reported to the grant funder, HRSA

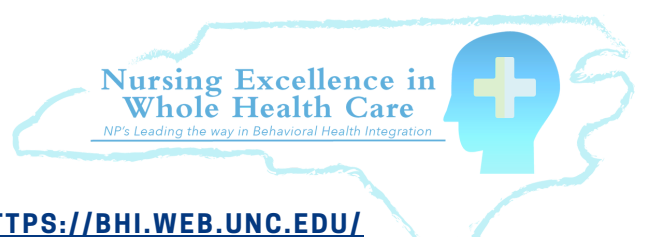
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PARTICIPANT SCHOLAR
